<b>Year 11</b>	<p>Project 1: Main Focus: Completion of Personal Portfolio unit for submission</p> <p>Students will complete work from Year 10, expand it and plan and produce a final finished piece/s based their preparatory work from the summer term.</p> <p>They will sketch and annotate different ideas through mind mapping and by creating a mock-up to help them visualise an outcome and refine their skills in their chosen medium.</p> <p>Students will be expected to complete their final piece of work as well as photograph their work and write an evaluation, reflecting on went well and what areas could be improved upon.</p> <p>They will undertake to achieve the personal portfolio requirements referring to and writing about artists and their work; showing clear development of personal ideas and producing observational drawings in a range of media to support their final piece.</p>	<p>Project 2 Externally Set Task</p> <p>Students have 10 to 12 weeks to develop ideas and research for their GCSE Externally Set Task, which is worth 40% of their GCSE grade. They will independently choose a theme set by the exam board, which will lead to a final piece of artwork.</p> <p>They will experiment with a range of media and show clear development of personal ideas and responses to their chosen theme This must be supported by observational drawings, in depth research and personal enquiry, and refer to the work of relevant artists.</p> <p>Students will need to plan their final idea/s for their final piece showing clear links to their preparation work in sketch books.</p> <p>Students will continue to work on their Personal Portfolio and start a new theme which relates to a previous theme and will strengthen their personal portfolio.</p> <p>Student's work will not be assessed during the preparation period but will be marked and moderated at the end of the unit as the planning and preparation is part of the exam.</p>	<p>Externally Set Task and completion of Personal portfolio</p> <p>Students will plan their final piece based on preparation work in sketchbook based on their chosen theme. They will sketch and annotate different ideas through mind mapping and by creating a mock-up to help them visualise an outcome and refine their skills in their chosen medium.</p> <p>The timed test will take place in the art room and will last 10 hours. The time will be spread out between two or three days during which time students will work independently to produce a final piece of artwork using a medium of their choice.</p> <p>Students will have a small amount of time to complete and refine their Personal portfolio before a date set by the exam board.</p>	<p>Have the confidence to work independently.</p> <p>Students will have confidence in their creative ability and be able to use art as a way of expressing themselves, their ideas, thoughts and feelings.
