SPRING TERM



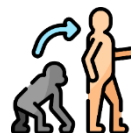
Students will look at different views including Humanist and non-religious. They will develop an awareness of words and phrases associated with these views and beliefs

To gain a general overview of what people mean by God and believe about God



To develop an awareness of words and phrases associated with the different theories / beliefs. Students will work on recalling stories, symbols and other forms of expression related to the views/ beliefs



To develop the ability to talk about their own experiences and feelings, what they find interesting or puzzling and what is of value and concern to themselves and to others

To gain a general overview of the views, beliefs and theories. Students will look at religious and non-religious views



SUMMER TERM

THEMES:
Creation, Big Bang, Evolution and other views and stories on origin.

To develop the ability to talk about their own experiences and feelings, what they find interesting or puzzling and what is of value and concern to themselves and to others
