AUTUMN TERM

To look at the impact of events such as natural disasters on wealth and poverty

THEMES: Similarities/ differences between religions. Diversity within religions

Students look at religions and know differences between them

Students recognise similarities between the different religions

Students compare and contrast with Humanist and other non-religious views

Students look at diversity within religions themselves

SPRING TERM



Students will look at prayer/ worship/ meditation/ mindfulness

To look at how believers from different parts of the world and different religions build a relationship with God

THEMES: How believers build a relationship with God

SUMMER TERM



Students will look at places of worship, holy sites and pilgrimages



To explore wealth and poverty and how it impacts the world through people and the environment



To identify the impact of events such as natural disasters on wealth and poverty

To look at the different views towards charity



To discuss the value of life versus the quality of life. Contemporary issues compared with religious views

THEMES: Wealth and poverty. How valuable is life?

To understand what life is like for different people around the world and the reasons for it
