Facilities

Wood Lodge is all on one level and is accessible for wheelchair users. It has 4 double student rooms and 2 staff bedrooms. The two bathrooms have been adapted for wheelchair users.

There are two staff showers. The two main living areas have comfortable seating for up to 10 people. The large adapted kitchen is well equipped and allows pupils to prepare their own meals.



Social Aspects

An important aspect for students staying at Wood Lodge is that they are given the opportunity to interact with adults and students in an informal setting. They gain invaluable social skills and develop confidence in coping with the problems of daily living.



Staffing

Staff members are usually from the school or college using Wood Lodge. Wood Lodge has a caretaker who looks after the general maintenance of the flats and garden. The flat is cleaned on a regular basis.



Living Skills

Wood Lodge gives students the opportunity to learn how to look after themselves. They make decisions about the food they will eat, clothes they will wear and important day to day living skills. It allows students to become more independent minded and confident about everyday tasks. Most users of Wood Lodge use a structured programme of practical activities which are closely linked to personal, social and health education being followed at their school or college.
