PROVISION

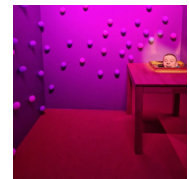
Miss B's KS5 English students have been reading *Avocado Baby* and finished the unit of work by making and preparing their own avocado wraps.
