| Assessment | Component 1: Internally Assessed Students complete two written booklets of information and research gathered about a professional performance. The written coursework is internally marked and moderated, before a sample is sent off to externally verify grades given. | Component 2: Internally Assessed Students create a workshop style performance of a scene from a script. Milestone performances and initial workshops are filmed and photographed to use as evidence. This is then marked and moderated internally, again before a sample is sent off to be verified. Students also have to complete a written reflection of their performance. | Component 3: Externally Assessed This component is marked by a visiting examiner who will watch the final workshop performance of each group piece. Students then have to complete a second written reflection of the whole process, from initial ideas, to final performance.
