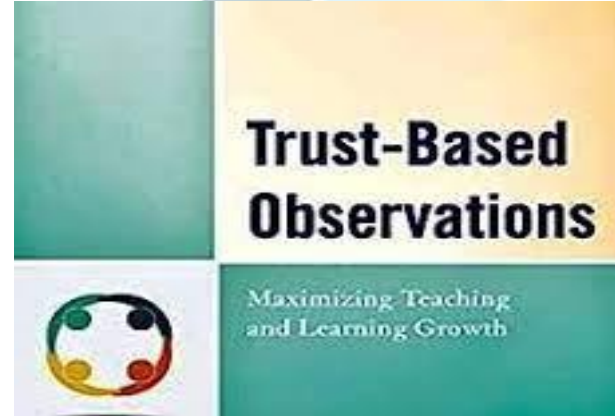

# *Parent Survey 2023*



- My child is well looked after in the school – 94%
- My child is happy in school – 90%
- I feel staff really know my child as an individual – 92%
- My child is encouraged to have good attendance & punctuality -97%
- Glebe school is well led and managed - 94%
- There is a good range of subjects available – 93%
- My child is taught well – 94%
- My child has a positive attitude to learning – 84%

# *School Results: August 2023*



- There were 107 GCSE entries this year.
- 386 entries across all subjects with 85% of pupils achieving 5 or more qualifications.
- There was a total of 13 GCSE grade 5 and 4 grades.
- 100% pass rate across all entry level qualifications.
- 88% of pupils achieved GCSE English, 92% Maths and 100% Science
- 100% of pupils achieved an English and Maths qualification
- Excellent results across BTEC subjects and other GCSEs
- Year 6s attended summer school
