Dear Parent/ Carer,

This letter is to inform you that the Occupational Therapist Ellen O'Riordan will be working in school on Wednesdays and Thursdays from September 2019.

Children's Occupational Therapists (OTs) help children achieve skills needed for home and school independence and also skills needed to play and enjoy interests. We call these young peoples 'occupations'.

At Glebe School, OTs work with the school team which can involve whole class, small group or individual work, which school staff support to implement throughout the school week. We will provide you with an end of therapy letter/report to inform you of your child's progress and next steps.

Your child may be referred to OT during this school term. If your child is referred for assessment by the school, Ellen O'Riordan, OT will contact you for further information and introduction. Please complete the form below if you **do not consent** to your child receiving Occupational Therapy input at Glebe School. If we do not receive this form back, we will know you are happy for us to work with your child.


