Dear Parents/Carers

Re: **SPORTS DAY AT NORMAN PARK ATHLETICS TRACK – Friday 10th June 2022**

We are very excited to announce that our sports day will be going ahead this year on **Friday 10th June 2022** at Norman Park Athletics Track. However, due to health and safety restrictions due to the building works at the athletics track, we will unfortunately be unable to allow parents to spectate. Whilst we are extremely disappointed that sports day has to happen behind closed doors, we are still thrilled that our students will be able to compete in sports day. We will be able to provide a DVD of the sports day so students can share their efforts with their families.

The number of teams has grown this year to accommodate the greater number of students. Your child will be advised whether they are in the Red, Blue, Green or Yellow team, and can wear a shirt with their team colours on the day. Students will be choosing the events they compete in and everyone will be actively involved. Students' chosen events will be finalised closer to the event.

All pupils who travel by Borough school transport will be collected from home and taken directly to Norman Park for **8.50am**. At the end of the day, which will be at **2.30pm**, these pupils will be collected from Norman Park and taken home. **If your child is normally on Borough Transport but you will be transporting them on this occasion, then please remember to inform Transport.**

Please provide your child with a packed lunch as school lunches will only be provided for those students entitled to free school meals. In the unlikely event that Sports Day is cancelled, your child will still need to bring a packed lunch.

In the unlikely event that Sports Day has to be cancelled due to extreme weather, school will run as normal on Friday 10th June, parents will be messaged via School Comms, the information will be posted on the website and school transport will be informed. Please ensure that your child brings clothing appropriate for the forecast weather, including sun cream, a hat and water to drink if it is hot. Students can bring a jumper or coat if rain is forecast.

We are required to inform you that if a situation arises where a child has an accident, the parents/carers will be contacted. In the event of a real emergency, any decisions for treatment will be taken by the medical professionals. Teachers will not be making decisions for medical treatment; they are not qualified to do so.
