

	<i>Technology Carousel - Textiles</i>	<i>Desired end of year outcomes</i>
Year 9 Textiles (10 weeks)	<p><u>Health and Safety Mini Project</u> Students are introduced to Health and Safety in the classroom and the importance of following rules, to keep themselves and each other safe.</p> <p><u>Introduction to Fabrics and Fibres – Mini Project</u> Students are introduced to a variety of fabrics and sort them into manmade and natural fibres. They will learn about the basic process by which fibres are made into fabric.</p> <p><u>Keyring Project</u> Students are introduced to basic equipment in this project and demonstrate they can work safely in the classroom. Students will use felt fabric and select appropriate equipment and materials to make a keyring. They will customise their keyring on a theme of their choice.</p> <p>The projects below will be implemented with different year 9 tutor groups, depending on the time of year that they complete the Textiles Unit</p> <p><u>Hand Puppet Project</u> Students design and make a hand puppet from felt or fur and decorate it using buttons, sequins, beads and googly eyes.</p> <p><u>Christmas Decoration Project</u> Students design and make a hanging Christmas decoration from felt or Christmas fabric.</p> <p><u>Easter themed project</u> Students design and make an Easter themed decoration or basket using felt and a variety of embellishments.</p> <p><u>Summer themed project:</u> Students design and make a sunglasses case using felt fabric and decorate it using ribbon, buttons and sequins.</p> <p><u>Repeat Pattern Project:</u> Students design a repeat pattern based on a theme and make either a cushion or a bag using their design.</p>	<p>Students will learn the basics of staying safe in the classroom. Students will be trusted to use equipment independently and possibly a sewing machine under close supervision.</p> <p>Students will learn stitching and printing techniques.</p> <p>Students will develop design skills and make design decisions independently. They will make choices based on their interests and tastes.</p> <p>Students will have a basic understanding of manmade and natural fibres and how they are made into fabric.</p>
