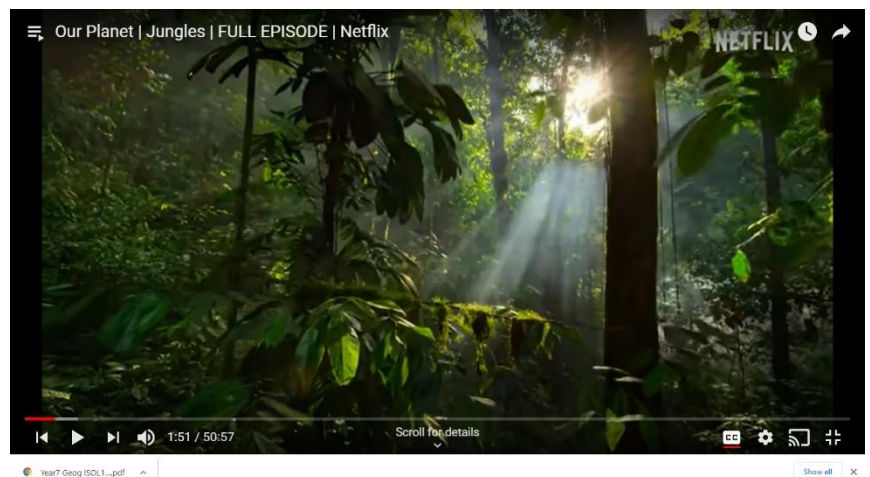
**Learning Objective:** To think about why rainforests matter
