

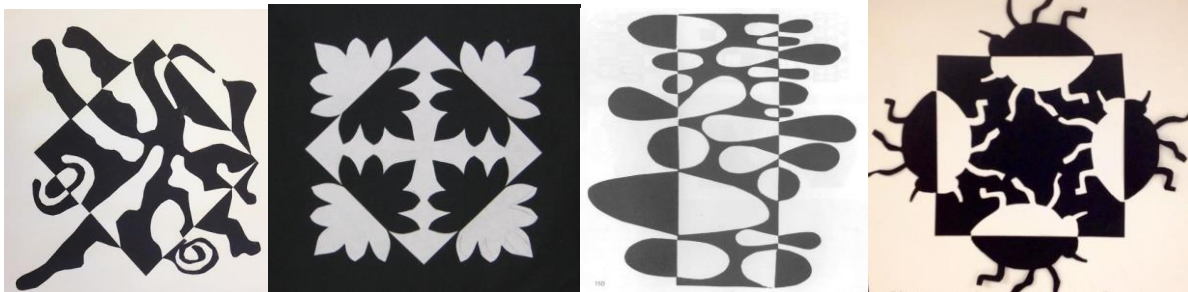

Subject: 6th Form BTEC ART and Design (Explore Printmaking) **Time to complete:** 50 minutes

Learning Objective: Produce at least two pieces of Notan Art. Notan is a Japanese term which literally means 'light dark harmony'. Artists use 'Notan studies' to explore different arrangements of light and dark elements in a painting, without having the distraction of other elements like colour, texture and finer details.
