### *The Clock Tower*

**Subject:** English Year 7 – Mrs North

**Learning Objective:** I can watch, understand and retrieve information from a film.

#### **Task 1: Watch the short animation of The Clock Tower.**

You may want to watch the film trailer through a couple of times.

#### **Task 2: Comprehension questions**

Now you have watched the animated short film, can you answer these questions either on paper or you can type them onto the computer.

#### **Pause the film after 8 seconds, when you get a glimpse of the town.**

1. What can you see in the setting?

#### **Pause the film on the clock face at 15 seconds**

2. How does a clock work?

3. What does the word clockwork mean?

4. Why might there be lots of balloons floating up into the sky?

#### **Pause the film as the girls leaves the doors at 43 seconds**

5. What has happened and how is the town different now?

6. How does this make us feel?

7. What colour sky could make us happy?

#### **Pause the film when the little girl tries to make the balloon move.**

8. How can she make the colour come back into the world?

#### **Pause the film until the end.**

9. What makes the colour in the world?

10. What is the little girl's job?

11. How do you think the little girl feels dancing in the tower all day?

#### **Extra questions to think about:**




Which other jobs might people have that makes them feel lonely?

#### **Task 4: Challenge - Point of view:**

Whilst watching the clip, choose three moments when you would like to hear an opinion from the dancer. Explain what is happening in the clip at that moment and then write in the speech bubble what you think the dancer would say if given the chance to share her thoughts.
