
TASK 1: Label the pirate ship

Pirates are people from any country who steal from ships at sea. (Yes, this still happens now but not quite as often!)

Pirates needed ships of their own (which they stole too) as they worked at sea, stealing riches from other ships.

SOURCE 1

Label the Pirate Ship




1. Hull – The bottom of the ship that touches the water.

2. Crows Nest – At the top of the ship. A place where sailors would stand to keep a look out.
3. Jolly Roger- This is a pirate flag that was put up when the ship was about to attack.
4. Rigging – The ropes and lines that hold up the sails.
5. Gun ports- The holes in the ship where the guns come out of.
6. Bow- The front part of the ship. The part that sticks out the furthest.
7. Sails- Made of fabric. When the wind blows they help the ship to move.

TASK 2- Look carefully at the 4 sources below. Identify and name each ship on the next page. Try not to look back at the sources when you identify the pirate ships.


SOURCE 1 - SLOOP

The sloop was one of the quickest ships available and that's why pirates liked them. Quick enough to out sail the enemy and good in shallow waters.




SOURCE 2- SCHOONER

Very similar to the sloop. It was known for its speed and its small size. Which made it good for hiding.




SOURCE 3- BRIGANTINE

Larger than the sloop and the schooner. A Brigantine Had more room and was more powerful.



SOURCE 4- A SQUARE-RIGGER

A pirate ship made for showing off! A square-rigger is so named because of its masts and sails. It includes the ship types of barques, brigs and full-rigged ships


