

Subject: MFL (Spanish) Time to complete: Around 50 minutes

Learning Objective: To practice weather vocabulary in Spanish using a weather chart.

Starter: Hola year 8s! On last week's homework you looked at Spanish phrases that we use to describe the weather. Let's warm up by practicing asking what the weather is like in Spanish. Click on the link below to hear me ask the question, then repeat it after me. Good luck!

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- a) What does 'Mañana' mean?
- b) What does 'Tarde' mean?
- c) What is the weather like on Friday morning? (answer in Spanish)
- d) What is the weather like on Wednesday?
- e) How many days has it been stormy?
- f) Is it windy on Saturday afternoon?

<u>El tiempo – The weather</u>

Llueve – It's rainy
Hace sol – It's sunny
Hay viento – It's windy
Hace calor – It's hot
Hay niebla – It's foggy
Hace frío – It's cold
Hay tormenta – It's stormy
Nieva – It's snowy
Está nublado – It's cloudy

Task 2: Well done answering the questions on task 1. Now, looking at the weather chart again, you are going to indicate whether the sentences below are Verdadero (True) or Falso (False). Use the link to your Collins dictionary if you need to translate the sentences. Here is an example:

El lunes por la mañana hace calor = Falso

The sentence says: **It's hot on Monday morning**. The answer is **False** because the weather chart shows that on Monday morning is rainy. Now is your turn!
