Smallest value

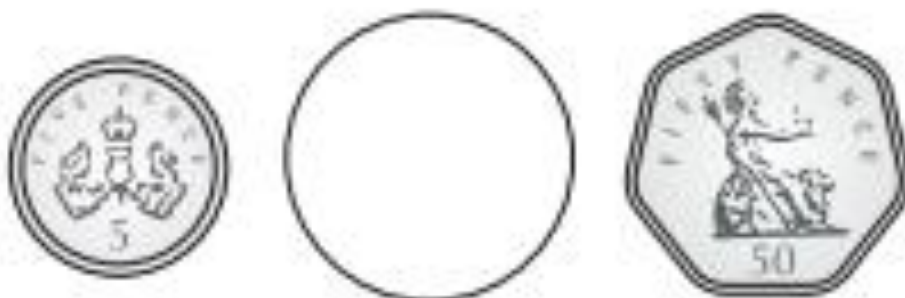

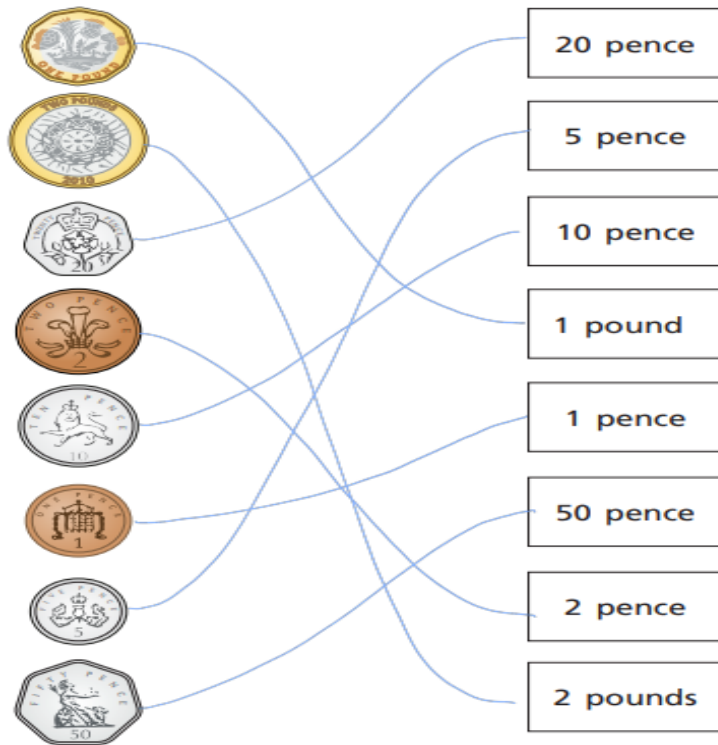
