

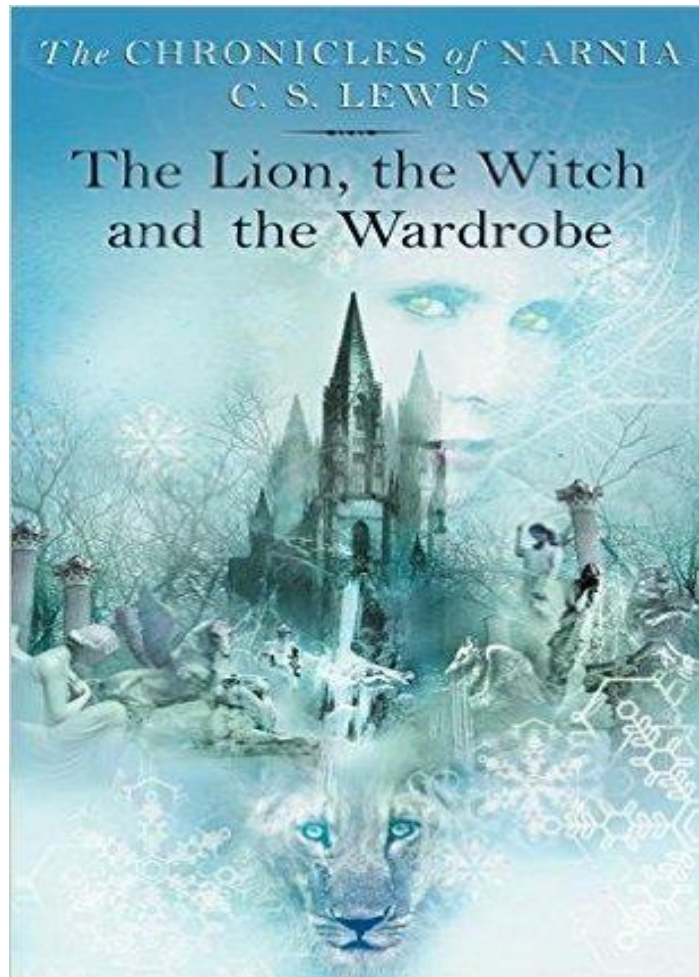

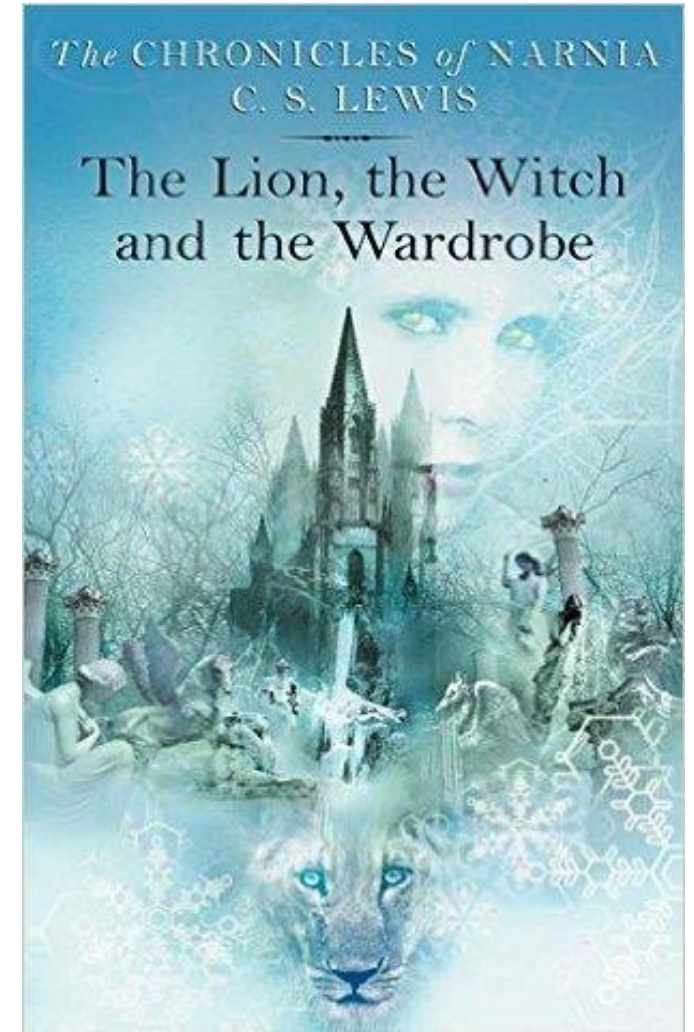

## Task 2: PREDICTION

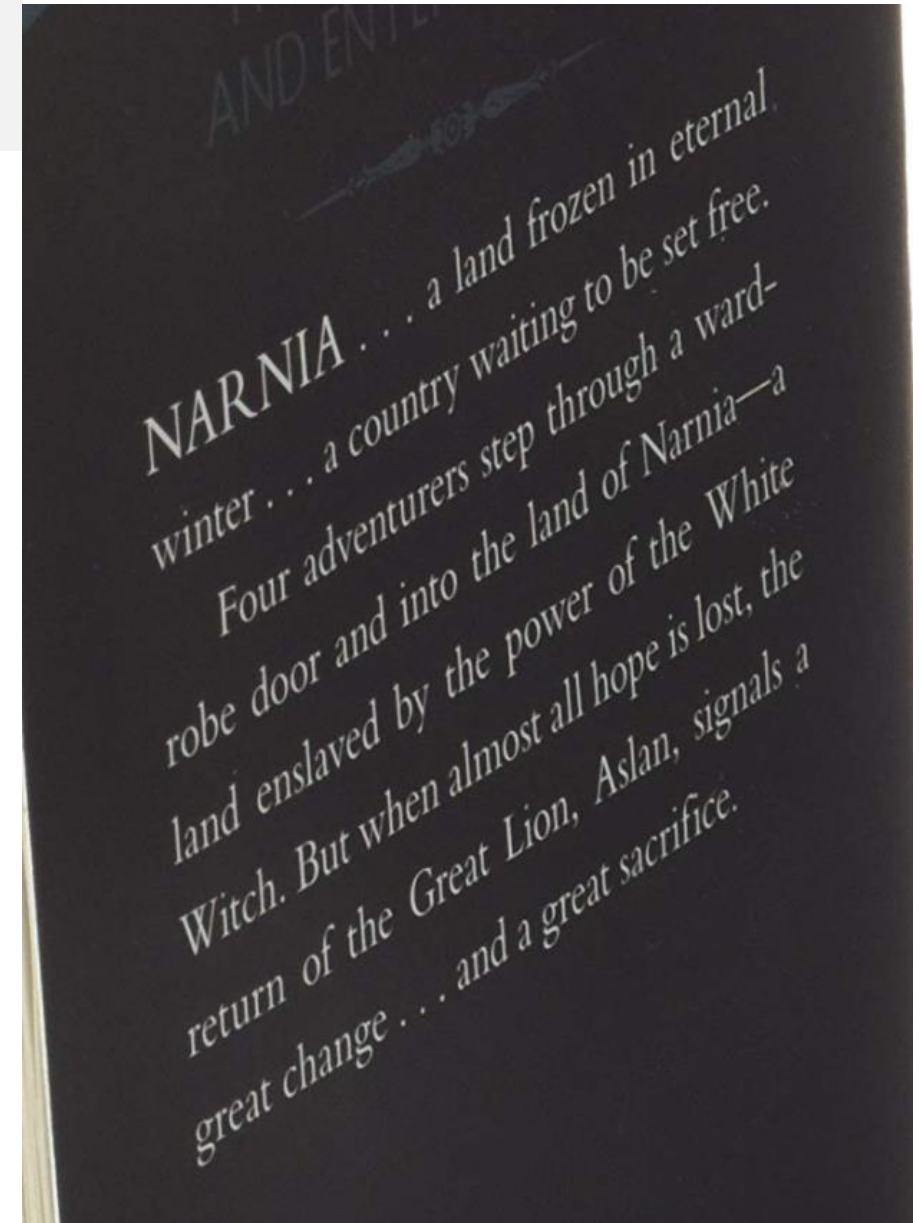
- Can you predict the text using the front cover?
