Subject: Drama Year 9 Miss Challenger

Learning Objective: I can continue to research my show and put on auditions for each character.

Putting on a Show Lockdown Project

Task 1: Researching your show

Now you have chosen your show, you need to find out all about it. Create a new mood board for your show research and copy your plot onto it.

You then need to see if you can find:

- Pictures of other performances
- What the stage looked like
- What the costumes looked like

Task 2: Characters

Next you need to find out about the different characters in your play, so you know how many actors you need to find. Try and research:

- How many characters there are
- What are the names of the characters
- What is each characters story (main characters)
- What personality they have

Task 3: Auditions

Then, using the research you have found create a leaflet advertising your auditions. You should include where, when and what you are going to put on, plus a list of the characters you want to audition for. Give each character a brief description of what you are looking for.
