<b>Year 11</b>	<p><b>Main Focus: Completion of Coursework unit for submission</b></p> <p>Students choose one of their bodies of work from Year 10, expand it and produce a final finished piece as their coursework submission. They will undertake to fulfil the coursework requirements of referring to and writing about artists and their work; showing clear develop of personal ideas and producing observational drawings in a range of media to support their final piece.</p> <p>All of the assessment objectives; including some writing about their work and that of other artists should be completed during the autumn term.</p>	<p><b>GCSE Exam.</b></p> <p>Students have 6 weeks to develop ideas and research for their GCSE exam piece. They will experiment with a range of media and show clear development of personal ideas and responses to a chosen theme.</p> <p>The exam itself last 10 hours and takes place over 2 whole days during which time students will work independently to produce a final exam piece in a medium of their choice.</p> <p>This must be supported by observational drawings, in depth research and personal enquiry, and also refer to the work of established artists.</p>	<p><b>GCSE presentation.</b></p> <p>Students will finish their coursework and exam submission making sure they have fulfilled all the assessment objectives. They will then work with staff to display their GCSE submission on to display paper and boards ready for the exhibition and moderation.</p> <p>There will be an exhibition of their work in May or June for moderation and to which parents/carers friends are invited.</p>	<p>Students will work independently, developing ideas and approaches and assessing their own work as they go.</p> <p>They will have the confidence to follow their own ideas and interests and show that they can experiment across a range of media.</p> <p>Students will complete and display a body of work for their coursework submission and a separate body of work for their exam submission.</p> <p>Students will have confidence in their creative ability and be able to use art as a way of expressing themselves, their ideas, thoughts and feelings.</p>
