Stats on E-safety

- 69% of young people use the internet privately without their parents supervision
- 1/3 young people have received nasty or sexual comments online.
- Only 7% of parents think their child has received such comments.



Dangers linked to social networking

- Sharing Personal information
- Cyber-bullying
